OTA 260 FIELDWORK II, PLACEMENT 1

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Prerequisites: Successful completion of all required OTA curriculum courses except OTA 261 and OTA 280.

Corequisites: This course must be completed within 18 months of the completion of all other OTA course work.

This course provides clinical experience under the direct supervision of experienced occupational therapists or occupational therapy assistant practitioners working in various practice settings. Emphasis is placed on final clinical preparation for entry-level practice in the profession. Upon completion, students should be able to meet all critical competencies for entry-level practice

- 18. Demonstrate positive interpersonal skills including responding appropriately to feedback, cooperating with team members, flexibility, tact and empathy.
